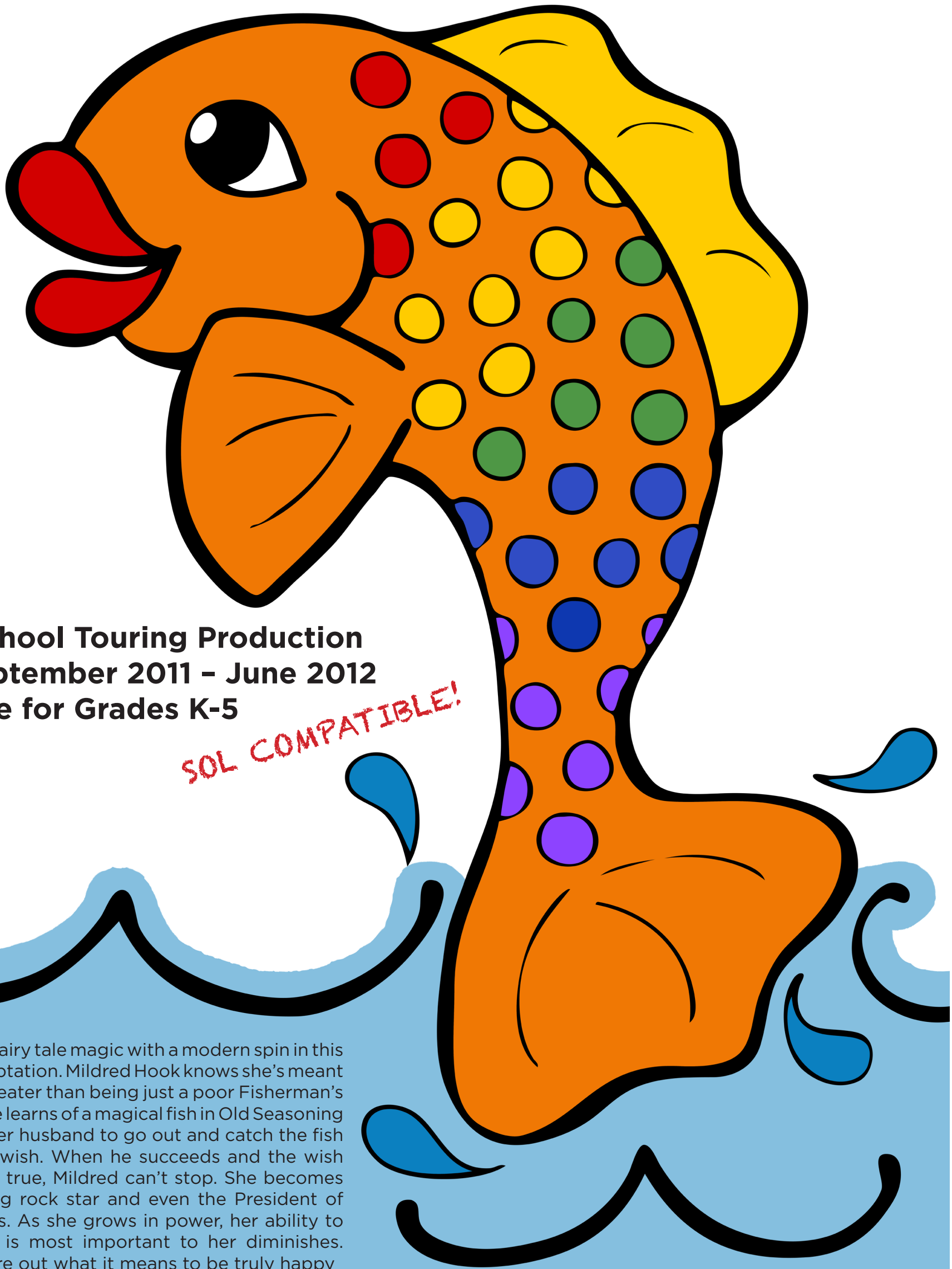


THE FISHERMAN AND HIS WIFE
